FEED INDUSTRY MEMORANDUM NO. 3-4

POLICY ON INTERPRETATION OF THE PHRASE "INDIVIDUAL MINERAL SUBSTANCES NOT MIXED WITH OTHER MATERIALS"

OBJECTIVE:

To clarify §141.002 (c)(6), of the Texas Commercial Feed Control Act, which provides exemption of individual mineral substances which are not mixed with other material(s).

BACKGROUND:

Occasionally, questions arise as to the practical definition of the term "individual mineral substance" as such appears in the Act.

POLICY:

The term "individual mineral substance," as expressed in §141.002 (c)(6) of the Texas Commercial Feed Control Act, is interpreted to include those defined in the AAFCO Official Publication Model Regulation under the Model Bill 1(c).
